1 Account Number

Each customer is assigned a unique water account number. Please provide your account number if you have any billing questions.

2 Previous Read

The meter reading at the end of the previous billing cycle is displayed here. This number represents the volume of water in CCF delivered through the meter before the current billing cycle. Each CCF represents 748 gallons of water.

3 Current Read

The meter reading at the end of the current billing cycle is displayed here. This reading indicates the total volume of water delivered to the service address by the end of the current billing period, measured in CCF.

4 Billing Range

This indicates the first and last days of service included in the bill.

5 Water Consumption History

The Water Consumption History chart shows a side-byside comparison for each month data is available. This helps customers see how water usage in the current year compares to the previous year.

6 Usage in CCF

Total of all water used during the billing period.

7 Current Activity

This section details all water use, fixed meter costs, infrastructure charges and any other charges that may apply for this billing period. Definitions for all charges are printed on the back of your bill.

8 Due Date

Payments must be received at the District office by the end of business hours on or before this date to avoid late fees

9 Previous Bill

This includes all charges from your most recent bill.

10 Payments

All payments made since the previous bill are included in this total.

11 Penalties

Any late fees or other surcharges are included here.

12 Charges & Adjustments Sub-Total

This shows the account balance at the beginning of the current billing period.

13 Total Amount Due

The total amount due represents the sum of all current and previous charges.

14 Mailing Address
