MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PICO WATER DISTRICT

A regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Pico Water District was held in the District's Boardroom located at 4843 South Church Street, Pico Rivera, California, on Wednesday, November 01, 2023 at 5:30 p.m.

The District's General Manager, Mr. Joe D. Basulto proceeded with the roll call of the attending Board members. Present from the beginning of the meeting was, Director David Angelo, Director Victor Caballero, Director David Gonzales, Vice President Raymond Rodriguez, President Pete Ramirez and Mr. Jim Ciampa, Legal Counsel for the District.

Director David Gonzales led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Director David Angelo gave the invocation.

President Pete Ramirez proceeded to the next item on the Agenda, Public Comments. Mr. Lee Squire presented and spoke to the Board of Directors regarding Central Basin Municipal Water District General Manger Alex Rojas vs El Rancho Unified School District defemination investigation for financial malfeasance. Mr. Squire did enter his presentation to the Board Secretary Mr. Joe Basulto who received it. Mrs. Carolyn Castillo then spoke regarding Central Basin Municipal Water District General Manger Alex Rojas when he was at El Rancho Unified School District and Mrs. Castillo reminded the Board about attending the Pio Pico's Women's club event on November 8, 2023.

President Pete Ramirez proceeded to the adoption of the Agenda. Director Victor Caballero made the motion to adopt and Director David Angelo seconded the motion. The General Manager announced that the motion passed by roll-call vote, 5-0.

President Pete Ramirez proceeded to the next item on the Agenda, approval of Consent Calendar. Director David Angelo made the motion to adopt and Vice President Raymond Rodriguez, seconded the motion. The General Manager announced that the motion passed by roll-call vote, 5–0.

President Pete Ramirez proceeded to the next item on the Agenda, Action/ Discussion Items. The General Manager stated that they were none at this time.

President Pete Ramirez proceeded to the next item on the Agenda, General Manager's Report. The General Manager reported that a Staff Monthly Meeting was held today 11/01/2023, staff reviewed Schedule of work for the Month of November, the quote of the Month is "Nothing will work unless you work".

Staff had 27 Turn offs for non-payment and 23 were turned on by end of day. Staff did encounter one mainline leak on 10/31/2023 at Nan St. on a 4" Main caused by Tree roots and have been repairing some minor service line leaks also, Completed Hydrant relocation for the City of Pico Rivera's Mines Ave. Project.

The General manager reminded the Directors that along with the Regular Board Meeting on November 15 there would be a Special Board Meeting on Thursday November 16 at 5:30pm, Civiltec will be presenting the water master plan, and going over our CIP Schedule, and after that Water Resources Economics will present the financial plan, leading to the Rate Study workshop in December.

President Pete Ramirez proceeded to the next item on the Agenda, Legal Counsel Report. Mr. Ciampa stated that there were no none to report.

President Pete Ramirez proceeded to the next item on the Agenda, Informational Items. The General Manager reported on the PFAS Project, the contractor RC Foster was on-site this week, finishing up the above ground piping at the discharge head of the Well #5A, we had our biweekly meeting yesterday, and there would be no on-site work pending material to start base paving and electrical work for the electrician at each site. And Status for permit to operate, we had a in-person meeting with AKM in Irvine to review all of DDW's comments, AKM is working on completing to submit our comments to them, we are thinking after DDW review's we may have to set up a meeting with them to address potential issues and finalize our permit to operate, then we can submit for Well #8 and 5A.

Water Levels for October 2023

Listed below are the water levels for the two key monitoring wells used by the Water Replenishment District of Southern California (WRD), and the District's active wells.

WRD is charged with monitoring the water levels in both the Central Basin and West Coast Basin, and with making sure both basins are replenished annually. As a means of monitoring the levels in both basins WRD measures the depth of water in two specific wells, 1601T located in between the San Gabriel River and the Rio Hondo spreading grounds, and the second Carson #1 located in the City of Carson. WRD compares the levels of these two wells month to month, and year to year as a means of gaging the reliability of both basins (levels listed are in feet below surface). As this report is specific to the Central Basin, we are only showing the Central Basin Monitoring Well results below.

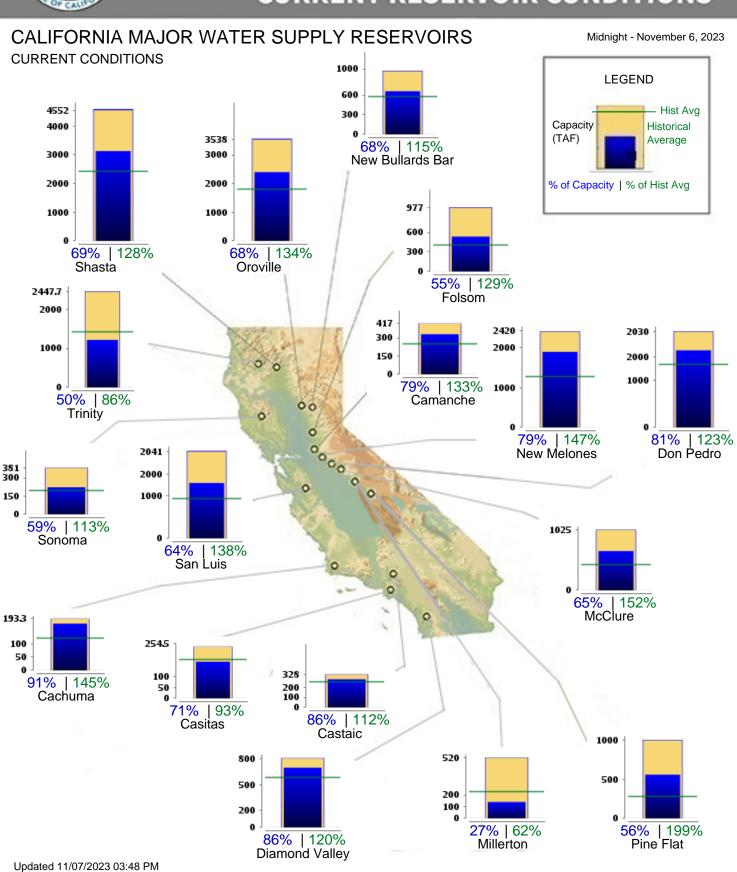
